Toll Gavel Redevelopment Scheme Recent Progress

Planning Application

We have used the latest plans (still on display in the Church and on the website) as a basis for a pre-application submission to East Riding of Yorkshire Council Planning Department. There will be a meeting with Council Officers in early July leading to advice about whether the scheme will need to be modified in order to attract Officer support. This will be fed into the scheme by our architect before the scheme is submitted for formal planning permission later in the year. The work leading up to the planning application will include professional advice about the acoustics of the building, the options for moving towards 'greener' energy solutions and the effect on the heritage of the building and the local area.

Funding

We are looking to submit a proposal during the summer to the National Lottery Heritage Fund for a substantial grant. Brian Gilliland is continuing to support us in this work. At the same time, we have made applications to the Circuit and District for grants to help with the cost of the planning process. Although we are still awaiting decisions, we are optimistic that we will be supported.

Wider Publicity

We have contacted a number of people and groups in the town (including ERYC and Town Councillors, the MP and heritage groups) to let them know what we are proposing and inviting them to come and look at the buildings and talk about what we do and how we see things moving forward. We have recently met with the Beverley Civic Society and had a useful discussion.


