Greetings from our new Pioneer Pastor!



I am Lydia, married to Mark, and have a dog in law called fizz (she lives very near us with Mark's parents, and she calls round for treats 3 times a day on her walks).

In my spare time I like to read, do creative things like needlefelting, painting, journalling, and collecting cows. I also visit a farm called Dumble Farm in Beverley where they have Highland cows. Despite my love of cows I am lactose intolerant, which feels like a juxtaposition!



I have been a Methodist all my life, being confirmed at 13 and become a trainee Local Preacher at 17. I was accredited as a Local Preacher in 2013, and the delay was moving to Yorkshire from Lancashire (I did have my passport stamped!), to do a Theology and Religious Studies degree at York St John and also meeting Mark shortly after graduation. During lockdown Mark and I teamed together to lead online worship for Huntington Methodist Church whilst the minister was on sabbatical. I also worked as Children and Family Work Enabler in the Goole and Selby Methodist Circuit for 6 years, doing things like TakeTime Meditations, toddler groups, preaching/leading intergenerational worship, Out Of The Box stories, Open The Book assemblies, activity boxes for families in lockdown and helping a local charity run a neurodivergent stay and play group for families in the Selby area. Before my work in Goole and Selby I worked as a support worker for adults with learning difficulties, and before that worked in an elderly care setting.

Mark has also been a Methodist all his life, helps with property and projection at Huntington Methodist. He works as an IT consultant and is also doing a masters at York Uni.

I did my training as a Pioneer with the Church Mission Society in 2022 and built some of what I learned in to my role at Goole and Selby as children and families worker (2019-2025). When this role came to an end I read the advert for this job and was instantly excited. It felt very much that the role was right up my street and in my skill set and I am looking forward to being part of the beautiful community that Beverley Mission area is! 


We are a group that meets on alternate Mondays in the Dog & Duck for lunch together and to plan future outings.
