single day!

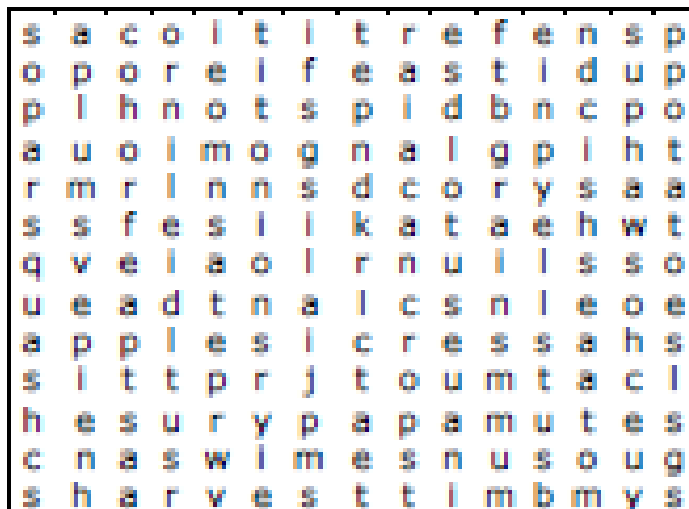
